Promote professionalism in public procurement by providing a forum for shared resources, education and networking for all members and stakeholders.

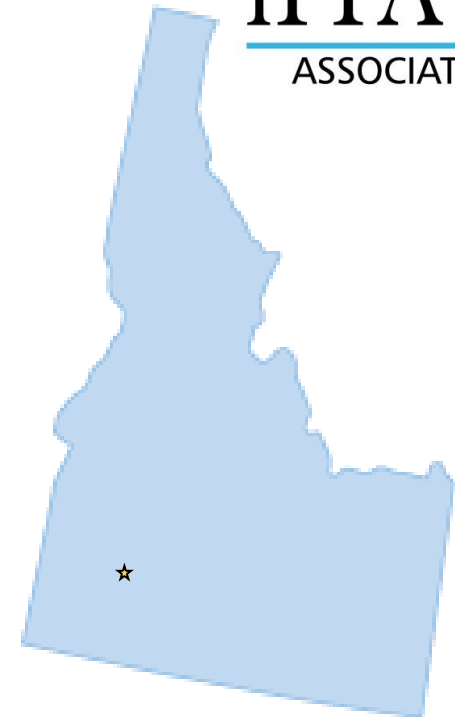
